Overdue Books


We currently have a huge number of overdue library books. Many of these books are from 2021. If you have any Palmerston DPS books in your home could you please return them?

2022 School Satisfaction & Climate Survey

Each year, the Directorate surveys all parents and carers, school staff and students in Years 4 to 12 about their experience of public education. The 2022 School Satisfaction & Climate Survey will be

available online from 19 August to 9 September. The survey results will help us to continue to make quality informed decisions about how to improve our school. No personal identifying information will be provided to any school or college. For each child in their family who attends an ACT public school, parents and carers will receive:

- An email about the parent survey, including a link to access the survey.; and
- A letter about the student survey outlining the reasons for collection and privacy provision for the data

If you do not receive the survey invitation (from the 19 August), please check your Junk email folder; if it is not there, contact the school and you will be provided a survey link. If you do not have an email listed with the school, please contact the office and an alternate arrangement will be made. The Parents and Carers Survey will be available online in other languages: Arabic, Burmese, Chinese, Hindi, Korean, Urdu, Vietnamese, Punjabi, Bengali, Spanish, Telugu, French and Italian. Respondents can select their preferred language when they start the survey. A shortened paper-version of the Parents and Carers Survey is also available in the following 5 languages: Dari, Dinka, Farsi, Karen and Mon. These surveys will be available at the Front Office. For the results to reflect the opinions of our whole school community, we need as many parents and carers, staff and students as possible to complete the survey. RAT TESTS



Opens Friday, 5 August 2022 and closes on Friday, 2 September 2022. The panel will review all entries and decide on winners by Thursday, 8 September 2022, with the winners' school contacted by Friday, 9 September 2022 to organise prizes.

The colouring in category: Designed with young students in mind (though not limited by age), students can colour the provided image and give a name to our new Legacy Bear mascot. The artwork must be the original work of the student, though teachers or parents can assist with writing the students answers for clarity if necessary. Please include student name, age, school, and suggested name for the Bear with the entry.

The creative writing category: Designed with older students in mind (though not limited by age), students can write in a style of their choosing (such as an acrostic poem, limerick, or short story), with their writing addressing the theme of Legacy. Addressing the theme of Legacy can be as simple as spelling out LEGACY in an acrostic poem, or as complex as writing a short story on what the student knows about Legacy or any experience with Legacy that they may have had. The response is to be no greater than 200 words. The creative writing piece must be the original work of the student and not published anywhere else before. No offensive or inappropriate work will be accepted. Please include student name, age, and school with the entry.
